Dr. George Farrand Taylor will preach on Sunday at the Congregational church on a theme much in the thoughts of Christians today—the necessity of union among the different divisions of Protestantism. He will deal somewhat with the "Concordat" which has been proposed as a basis of reunion between the Presbyterian and Episcopal churches. "The desirability of the agreement", the New York Times reports, "has been a matter of argument for many months. Bishop Manning of New York is approving and so are many prominent laymen and women. Dr. Merrill, the author of 'Rise Up O Men of God', who is probably one of the most outstanding of Presbyterians is back of the movement." Dr. Taylor will deal with the principal objection to the plan as proposed by the Episcopalians, namely the doctrine of apostolic succession, and what the real meaning behind that doctrine is. It is said that the "Concordat" is striking snags among both churches but that the wish for union will probably find some other proposal which will command assent of both churches.

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
