Home Savings Increase

The report of the Tryon Federal Savings & Loan Association published in Friday's Bulletin showed an increase during the past month in total assets from \$308,934.56 to \$315,765.10; a gain of nearly \$7,000 during the month. The total private investments increased over \$1,000 a week, jumping from \$233,407.70 to \$238,768.79. The interest paid on these investments is about twice that received from many savings institutions, and the investments have the federal agency insurance protection up to \$5,000 on each investment.
