The sale was made this week through Chas. J. Lynch. Work is already underway restoring the house to its former grandeur of colonial days. The house is located on the old Greenville-Rutherfordton stage coach line, one of the oldest roads in this section and is near Prince Fort on Pacolet River where a battle of the Revolutionary War was fought. This is the first time the property has been out of the hands of the Earle family since the original land grant from the King of England. Mr. and Mrs. Munns and Mrs. Hollingshead are now in Tryon stopping at Pine Crest Inn.
