RUTHERFORD DAIRY TO OPEN IN FALL

Rutherfordton, N. C., May 20—Rutherford Dairies, Inc., is the title of a new industry for this county which will open early this fall and employ 15 or more people. It will be located in East Spindale.

Authorized capital is \$40,000, with \$5,000 paid in by Gordon Moore, James Moss, J. J. Hamlin, R. M. Morris and William Carpenter. It will be a milk pasteurizing plant—first of its kind in this county. The purpose will be to buy raw milk from the farmers and serve the county with milk and other dairy products.

The new plant will be equipped to handle one thousand gallons of milk daily. Officers are W. T. Carpenter, president; James Moss, vice-president; J. J. Hamlin, secretary-treasurer. The officers with Mr. Moore and Mr. Morris will be directors.
