# **Vaccination Clinics** 1945 VACCINATION CLINICS FOR TYPHOID, WHOOPING COUGH DIPHTHERIA, SMALLPOX

The Polk County Health Department will hold clinics at the following places at the times named below to vaccinate against the above-named diseases. These treatments will be given free. A State Law requires that all children between the ages of six months and one year be vaccinated against Diphtheria and Whooping Cough and all children are required to be vaccinated for these diseases and Smallpoor before entering school. It is the patriotic duty of every citizen to keep himself and his family in good health. The Health Department urges you to go to your family doctor or to the nearest dispensary point and secure protection against these catching diseases.

We cannot cover the county with vaccination clinics and do the rest of our work unless you cooperate by being on hand when we arrive at the clinic Children who were given one dose of toxoid for point. diphtheria at the preschool clinics should go to one of the above points for the second dose.
