

Weather Wednesday: High 68, low 56, rain .16; Thursday high 61, low 32 . . . President Harry Truman took the oath of office as President on Thursday noon. Chief Justice Fred Vinson administered the oath. Senator Barkley became Vice-president. One million people were in Washington for the ceremonies. Truman is the first Demo-cratic Vice-president to become President in over 100 years, since William John Tyler succeeded Henry Harrison at his death in 1841, Truman is the first Demo-Sident since Martin Van Buren who was inaugurated in 1837 to succeed Andrew Jackson, who had completed two terms. Franklin D. Roosevelt was the only Demo-cratic President to die in office and he was on his fourth term. something unusual. . . In his inaugural speech Truman urged support of the United Nations Aid for world economic recovery, higher world standard, and a crusade against Communism . . .
