

Organized Reserve Corps Meets Monday, Aug. 8th

Tryon now has its own training unit in the Organized Reserve Corps. This unit, the 3554th Complement, Post, Camp, or Station (small training), was activated by General Orders No. 153, Hq. 3rd Army, June 30, 1949. The commanding officer is Lt. Col. William G. Ashmore of Tryon.

The new unit is authorized a strength of 24 officers, 2 warrant officers, and 51 enlisted men. It is also authorized to hold two "pay" training sessions per month. The personnel of the unit is to be made up of active reservists of this area, including the Rutherfordton, Saluda, Spindale and Forest City areas.

The next meeting of the unit will be held at Sunnysdale on Monday, Aug. 8, at 7:30 p. m. At this time Maj. W. N. Cowan, the unit instructor for this district, will be present to give advice and information as the new training program gets underway.

All active reservists are requested to be present; and former army personnel—not now active—who would like to receive information about the program are cordially invited.
