Feldspar Plant Rebuilding Is Progressing

Spruce Pine.—A crew of about 40 men is at work rebuilding the Feldspar Flotation Corporation plant here which was damaged by fire July 30th.

The dryer section, in which the fire started, is being replaced by a concrete and steel structure. A 30-by-87-foot addition, for storage purposes, is being made to the main building.

Spokesmen for the corporation estimated that completed cost of the rebuilding operation will be in excess of \$150,000. They anticipate that the plant will be ready to resume full operations about October 1.

The new plant will have a capacity for processing approximately 4,500 tons of rough material a month. From this is produced feldspar, fine mica and quartz sand. Chief source of supply are large deposits in the Piney Branch section near Spruce Pine. At the time of the fire the plant was

said to be employing about 60 persons and was operating on three shifts daily, seven days a week.—Asheville Citizen.
