It will be several days before the contract is signed but all concerned seem to think the deal would go through. Mr. Pucket who has a home on Howard Gap Road, Tryon, formerly operated the Cleveland Hotel in Spartanburg and now owns a large apartment house in Atlanta, Ga., and is president of the Savannah Hotel at Savannah, Ga. The 200-room million dollar building also has \$200,000 in furnishings and equipment. . . . Evans Cannon, general secretary of the Spartanburg YMCA which owns a youth camp on Skyuka Mountain, here, was presented the Spartanburg Kiwanis trophy for outstanding community achievement Thursday night in Spartanburg. Charles E. Cauthen made the presentation address . . . Congratulations to the Tryon Federal Savings & Loan Association which has passed the two million dollar mark in total resources; paid out over \$54,000 in dividends to depositors which included 682 investors who helped
