

Tryon Paratrooper In New York Maneuver

Camp Drum, N. Y., Jan. 24.—Pfc. Lee M. Burrell, currently serving with the 11th Airborne Quartermaster Parachute Maintenance Co., 11th Airborne Division, son of Mr. and Mrs. Mark Burrell, Tryon residents, is participating in the joint Army-Air Force maneuver "Exercise Snowfall" now underway in northern New York.

The operation is designed to test the latest in cold weather clothing and equipment and the battle efficiency of the individual soldier under simulated combat and adverse weather conditions.

Pfc. Burrell enlisted in the Regular Army in March 1951, taking his Infantry basic training at Fort Jackson, S. C. In May, 1951, he volunteered for parachute duty and received his airborne training at the Parachute School, Fort Benning, Ga. Upon completion of the course, the Tryon paratrooper joined the 11th Airborne Division.

Prior to entering the service, Pfc. Burrell was employed by the Adams-Millis Corp.
