

POLK FARMS AIDED

Under the 1951 Agricultural Conservation Program, 258 farmers in Polk County were given assistance for the establishment of 1,166 acres of permanent pastures. Assistance represented 50% of the cost of the materials with the farmers doing all the work. Clint Swain, chairman of the County PMA Committee, reports this acreage represents additional grazing land for the increasing number of livestock in the county.

Through the ACP, more and more farmers in the State have come to realize that livestock is assuming a greater importance each year in their farming system. This has brought about an increased emphasis on permanent pastures, not only for use as feed but for its recognized value as a soil-improving and soil-saving measure.

Mr. Swain said that conservation practices, encouraged by the ACP, have increased the yield of pasture and forage crops, which is reflected in current production of livestock and livestock products. The lime, phosphates and other plant foods, which have been used by farmers through cooperation in the ACP, has stimulated soil improvement through grasses and legumes and has helped to build up these pastures to their present high yields.
