Hum. 62 Tomorrow, Tuesday is an important day for Tryon and its future. The voters will be called on to vote for or against the extension of our water resources. Tryon has never defaulted in its bonds even during the depression. The debt is reduced to such an extent that it is safe to borrow more money at half the rate of interest the other bond issue required and let future revenue from water consumers pay for the new debt. Our town officials have unanimously recommended it to the voters. It is up to us to give approval if we want the community to grow. Landrum voted for bonds last week in order to increase its water supply. Asheville is spending over two million dollars to increase its water resources. This is one problem the Town Commissioners can't act on without a vote of the people. You
