Weather Friday: High 53, low 48, rain .52, Rel. Hum. 95; Saturday high 50, low 41, rain .86, Rel. Hum. 93; Sunday high 52, low 39, rain .02, Rel. Hum. 46 . . . The weather is bad over much of the nation. Snow and ice storms as far south as Asheville and Atlanta; cold, rain and floods. Florida was hit by storm that uprooted trees and blew over trailers and damaged stores. New England under heavy blanket of snow. Over 50,000 people in New York, New Jersey and Connecticut without electric power. In Tryon area heavy winds blew down some trees and in a few places power lines and telephone lines were down. Dams-Millis plant closed Monday morning while power lines were being restored.
