Col. Arthur Lewis Smith, 78, died Thursday at 1 p. m., at St. Luke's Hospital. He had been in declining health for several years.

Funeral services will be held Scturday at 3 p. m., at the Concational Church in Tryon with Rev. Orville H. White officiating. Interment will be at the National Cemetery in Arlington on Monday. Petty Funeral Home in charge of service here.

Col. Smith served as a chaplain in the Spanish-American War and World War 1. During World War II he traveled over the U. S. helping to establish Masonic recreation centers for the service men. He had been a part time resident of Tryon for about 45 eyars, owning Tryon Hills and other property here and operating real estate interests in Washington, D. C. He was a native of Summerfield, N. C.
