TREE FARMS IN N. C.

Washington, D. C.—(Special)— Tree farms in North Carolina now total 613.812 acres, James C. Mc-Clellan, chief forester, American Forest Products Industries, reported today.

He said 77 tree farms, all privately-owned, tax-paving properties, are represented in that acreage. A total of 14,954 acres was added to the Tar Heel state's Tree Farm System in 1952.

The N. C. Tree Farm System was launched May 17, 1944, by the N. C. Forestry Assn. The Southern Pine Assn. cooperates in sponsoring the program. Private forestland owners may qualify for Tree Farm certification by managing their property for the continuing production of useful wood crops. Since 1941 the program has spread to 35 different states, where 4,209 woodland owners now are practicing wise management on 27,672,228 acres of crop-producing forestland.
