The North Carolina Veterans Commission will have Jack C. Winchester, District Service Officer, with the County Service Officer in the Court House, Columbus on Thursday, April 2, from 11 a. m. to 4 p. m., and he will be in the County Service Office, Court House, Rutherfordton, on Friday, April 3, from 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p. m.

Mr. Winchester stated the deadline for making application to receive the second prisoner of war payment of World War II, is April 9. Veterans, servicemen or dependents, who are entitled to this benefit of \$1.50 for each day held prisoner, must file application for

this by the deadline.

The Service Officer also stated that men who received dental treatment in World War I, World War II, or the Korean conflict should make application for home town dental treatment, which can be granted to certain veterans who meet the requirements. Veterans, who are now being discharged, should file application for this

treatment as soon as sanarated from service, and, by all ans, file in time for the Veterans Administration to give authorization and receive the treatment within one year afer discharge, Mr. Winchester concluded.
