

The financial responsibility act, which will affect each of the estimated million and a third motorists in North Carolina, was passed by the 1953 General Assembly and becomes effective automatically on Jan. 1, 1954. The act, designed to guarantee compensation to innocent victims of auto crashes for both personal injuries and property damage, requires a written report—by the car owner or operator involved—of any accident which results in serious injury, death or property damage of \$100 or more. Such reports must be made within 24 hours following the accident to the financial responsibility section of the Motor Vehicles Department.
