LET FAMILIES KNOW

The need for veterans to tell their families where important veterans' documents are kept cannot be over-emphasized, the Veterans Administration has advised.

Safeguarding discharge papers, marriage certificates or child custody evidence from fire, theft or loss could be one of the most important legacies a veteran can leave his survivors, according to VA Regional Director, Kenneth E. McDonald. Among documents that should be protected and filed with family papers are government and commercial life insurance policies, any VA correspondence with identifying claim or social security numbers, wills and, where applicable, naturalization papers.

Families should also be aware

of possible survivors benefits McDonald said. These include VA pensions, dependency and indemnity compensation for service connected death, burial benefits and interment in a national cemetery.

A few minutes spent by the veteran organizing documents and informing his family can do much to avoid anguish during times of emotional stress, McDonald suggested.

Veterans and their families can obtain information and assistance concerning benefits from any VA regional office. Assistance is also available through veterans service organizations.
