# For Brain Surgery

Addressing the Green Creek Ruritan Club at their Tuesday night dinner meeting this week was Dr. Paul C. Bucy, an internationally recogized neurosurgeon, who spoke in behalf of the American Cancer Society on the incidence of brain tumors, both benign and malignant. He pointed out that cancerous tumors rarely originate in the brain, but migrate there from other parts of the body, most often from a cancerous lung.

Dr. Bucy, who began his career in neuro-surgery 52 years ago, described the progress of brain surgery since its primitive beginnings and outlined its advance to today's sophisticated techniques which include use of computerized axial tomographic scanners, microsurgery for the repair of tiny blood vessels, and radioactive isotopes to locate tumors of the brain. He held his audience spellbound with his detailed knowledge and clear exposition. — Reporter
