Eastern Flora At Bird Club

"Color, Form and Variation" as found in nature will be the subject of an illustrated slide talk by Ivan J. Kuster Thursday at 10 a.m. at the March meeting of the Tryon Bird and Nature Club in the Fellowship Hall of the Tryon United Methodist Church.


