The Landrum City Council met Tuesday night and voted to buy radio-phone equipment for a second police car. The first was installed two weeks ago.

In other action the Council approved the first reading of an ordinance regulating the licensing of dogs; voted to refinance the \$1,250,000 loan with Farmers Home Administration; adjusted a water bill for Church of God of Pophoccy; passed a resolution agreeing for sidewalk construction on South Church Street with the S. C. Highway Dept.; approved the first reading of annexation petitions from Mrs. Cora Boyd and James Boyd, whose property adjoins the City Limits.

Dan Young brought the Council up to date on the City-County Recreation program and Police Chief Neil Ayers gave his report and requested the purchase of a tape recorder for the courtroom. This request was approved by the Council.
