and again these penalties for drunken driving in North Carolina, but have you ever thought what it would be like if it actually happened to you? Think for just a moment what it would be like if you lost your driver's license and could no longer go whenever or wherever you wanted. Think for just a moment how embarrassing it would be to have to spend some time in jail. Think what a waste it would be to have to pay out several hundred dollars in fines and get nothing new and shiny in return. Consider the possibility of death or serious injury to person or property. When you stop to think about it. drunken driving is not worth the penalty you must pay to do it.

BAGGING.

To help make sure your groceries get bagged the way you want, help the checker by unloading heavier items first.

Save the fragile and perishable foods until last to avoid getting damaged on automatic conveyor belts, recommend specialists with the North Carolina Agricultural Extension Service.

Also, it is easier for packers to place the more fragile items on top of the bag.

Request that frozen foods be packed in an extra bag if there will be a delay in storing them.
