ULTRASOUND EQUIPMENT

Howard H. Spika, President of St. Luke's Hospital, Inc., Columbus, N. In its role as coordinator of project reviews under Section 1122 of the Social Security Act and the Certificate of Need Program, the Certificate of Need Section will receive the advice of the regional agency about the conformity of the project to their standards and criteria.

The Department will the n decide on the recommendation to be made to the United States Department of Health and Human Services concerning Section 1122. The Department of Human Resources is the final authority with respect to decisions made under Chapter 131. Article 18, of the General Statutes of North Carolina.
