To the Editor:

On July-29 the state elections board will meet to consider an issue of considerable importance to citizens of North Carolina: whether or not we will have the opportunity in November to vote for John Anderson as an independent candidate for president of the United States.

The Independents for Anderson Party of North Carolina, certified by the elections board last month, has met all state legal requirements and Anderson's name has already been tentatively placed on the ballot. The Democratic Party, however, has challenged Anderson's right to be on the ballot in this state. The Democrats have raised similar objections in other states; rulings have been in Anderson's favor. Essentially what this challenge means is that Anderson is being forced to waste valuable campaign funds in fighting it. (The two major parties will receive almost 30 million dollars each in federal funds for campaign use; Anderson, as an independent, receives no federal monies.)

Representative Anderson is a serious presidential candidate; he is running to win, not to be a spoiler for another candidate. Polls show that he is gaining in popular support as more and more Americans are finding that he embodies the qualities we so desperately need in a president.
