Kangaroo To Help Prevent Crime

A new program aimed at teaching young school children about the dangers of shoplifting will be introduced in the local schools this fall through the efforts of the Tryon City and Polk County School Systems, businesses, the Sheriff's Department, Police Departments and Lileco Division of Texar Corp. in Columbia, S. C.

The Polk County Crime Control office with Mike Wallace as program director is sponsoring the program. The program will introduce the 3rd, 4th and 5th grade students in Polk County to "Hugh the Kangaroo" the character with human-like ways to understand that shoplifting is wrong. The campaign slogan is "Help Hugh Blow the Whistle on Shoplifting."

The young students will receive an illustrated story book plus other educational materials, an activity book featuring Hugh, posters, plus a Hugh Club membership card, pledge scroll and a Hugh Whistle. The package will also include a teacher's guide, a message to parents, plus filmstrips and cassettes.

Shoplifting in the United States amounted to an excess of 8 billion dollars in 1979. The losses alone cost each American hundreds of dollars per year in increased prices at the retail level. Over one-half of all shoplifters are juvenile, with girls outnumbering boys 20 to 1. A shoplifting theft occurs every 5 seconds in the United States.

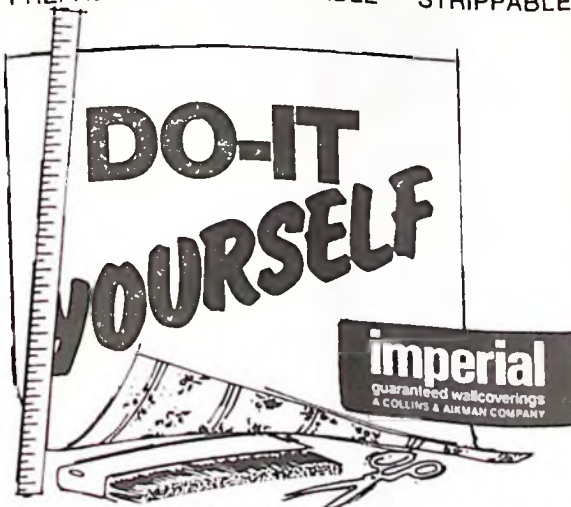
