

## 4-H Leader Convention Set For November 1-2 In Raleigh

Polk County 4-H Leaders will have an opportunity to join other leaders across the state at a Volunteer 4-H Leader Convention Nov. 1-2 in Raleigh.

The convention theme is "Sharing The Lead," according to Deborah Johnson, Assistant Extension Agent, 4-H.

"This convention has been

planned and will be conducted by volunteer 4-H leaders who represent all districts of the state," the agent said.

Leaders will make presentations or supply demonstrations on their particular involvement in their county and/or district programs.

The highlight of the convention will be the approval of a constitution and the election of officers for a North Carolina Volunteer 4-H Leader's Association. Miss Johnson pointed out that the program also includes workshops, sharing sessions, idea fairs, displays, exhibits, a square dance and pig picking.

The registration begins at 8 a. m. on Saturday, Nov. 1 and the convention will end at noon on Sunday. It will be held at the McKimmon Center at North Carolina State University.

An eight dollar registration fee includes a materials packet and the luncheon and pig picking on Saturday.
