Clifford Fields, Director of the Health Dept. for Polk, Rutherford and McDowell Counties along with Paul Toney, Chief Animal Control Officer for these counties visited the "PCAPS" October Board Meeting. Mr. Toney is also a member of the "PCAPS" Board. They answered numerous questions and reviewed the support which the county gives the Society. Since Mr. Fields is in charge of and supervises the animal shelter in Rutherford and the animal control program, his explanation of their organization and procedures were helpful and informative for the Society's Board members.

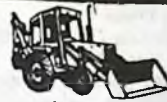

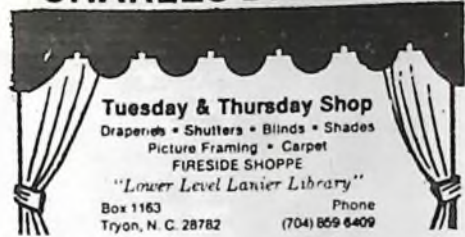
