4 Minutes To Eternity

In 1980 about 1,500,000 Americans will have a heart attack and about 650,000 of them will die. Almost 350,000 a year die of a heart attack before they reach a hospital. The average victim waits three hours before deciding to seek help. There are two definitions of "death", clinical and biological. Clinical death occurs when there is no breathing and no circulation (no heart beat, no pulse.).

Biological death occurs when oxygen in body tissue is exhausted and irreversible brain damage has begun. When clinical death has occurred, the administration of CPR within minutes may turn clinical death back to productive life. In most instances if CPR is administered within 4 minutes life may be restored and brain damage is unlikely; administration of CPR within 4-6 minutes may "possibly" restore life without brain damage; after 6 minutes CPR is "unlikely" to restore life without brain damage. — Reporter
