Stop Smoking Classes To Start

The eight-session Stop Smoking Class scheduled to begin at 7:30 p.m. Sunday, June 7, is designed to help teenagers as well as older smokers.

According to a 1977 publication of the U. S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare, more research data are available on teenage girl smokers than on teenage boys, because of the concern over the rapid increase in teenage girl smokers.

The book points out that out of an average 66% of teenage girls and young women who have tried to kick the tobacco habit, only 13% have succeeded.

Among young women, those most likely to quit are younger, more athletic, more active in clubs and more likely to be employed. Potential quitters in the teenage group are very interested in physical exercise, think of themselves as more popular than most, as leaders, and are active in clubs and groups in and out of school.

Both teenage girls and boys will be welcome to the group therapy sessions, which will incorporate films, informative lectures, explanations of smoking cessation procedures and group interaction.

Meetings will run from 7:30 to 9 p.m. Sunday, June 7 through Thursday, June 11, and three other Monday evenings: June 15 and 22, and July 6. They will be held in the St. Luke's Hospital classroom.

Sponsoring the program are St. Luke's Hospital, the Polk County Cancer Society and the Tryon Seventh-day Adventist Church.
