Q. How can I tell if my child is having trouble seeing?

A. The only sure way is by having your child's vision thoroughly examined. Yet there are signs that may indicate it is time to make an appointment with your doctor of optometry.

Consistently sitting too close to the television, preferring reading to outdoor activities or squinting when looking at something far away are all signs of vision problems.

Others are frequent scowling, blinking or rubbing of the eyes; consistent clumsiness; poor eyehand coordination; a short attention span for the child's age; covering one eye or tilting of the head when reading or complaints of nausea, dizziness or headaches after reading or doing other close work.

The best way to protect your child's vision is to schedule vision examinations annually and not wait for trouble signs.
