Columbus Budget

The Columbus proposed budget for 1981-82 was presented at the June 8th meeting of the Town Council and is available for public inspection at the Town Office. The second Revenue Sharing hearing as well as final approval of the 1981-82 budget will be June 29th at 7 p.m. at the Columbus Town Hall.

The proposed tax rate will be 38c per \$100 valuation of property listed for taxes as of Jan. 1, 1981. The total budget is \$161,426. Of this amount \$41,040 is from ad valorem taxes; \$500 privilege license; \$18,800 Utilities Francise tax; \$13,421 from Intangible personal property tax; \$12,009 Powell Bill Street from Allocation; \$19,321 from local 1% sales tax; \$25 for building permits; \$7,690 refuse collection fees; \$10,512 from Revenue Sharing; \$300 Sales Tax Refund; Balance \$21.978 Fund Appropriated (Powell Bill); \$5,023 General Fund Balance -Appropriated; \$10,807 Revenue Balance Sharing Fund Appropriated.

The Town expects to spend \$27,678 for administration; \$14,000 for police; \$5,350 for fire; \$66,467 for streets; \$15,516 for sanitation; \$20,179 for nondepartmental; \$8,071 for contingency; \$4,165 for capital
