A strong carthquake rocked a 200-mile swath of Southern California on Wednesday, triggering land slides onto highways, breaking windows, topping at least one wall and causing widespread minor damage. It measured 5.5 on the Richter scale and was centered three miles northwest of Upland, a city about 40 miles east of Los Angeles.

Legislators overwhelmingly aproved a bill Wednesday that allows Soviets to acquire land and bequeath it to their chidren, a major modification of decades of state control of land.
