The Soviet lawmakers made a drastic break with Communist orthodoxy Tuesday by voting to allow private citizens to own small factories and hire their own workers.

Republican National Committee Chairman Lee Atwater, who collapsed Monday while giving a speech, has a benign tumor on the right side of his brain, doctors announced Tuesday.

America's premier spy plane — the SR-71 Blackbird — set a transcontinental speed record Tuesday before retiring to a museum home. The black, dagger-shaped aircraft went from coast to coast in 68 minutes, 17 seconds, arriving at Washington Dulles International Airport to the cheers of hundreds of onlookers. The old record was 3 hours, 38 minutes, set in 1963 by a Boeing 707.
