Through ADRA, work is done to help the poor in developing countries and respond to the needs of disaster victims, including people facing hunger. Aid is given without regard to ethnic, religious or political association

Sipkens' report will involve only a segment of the territory in which ADRA is active. Recent information from ADRA International tells of plans to distribute 10,780 metric tons of food to people in the Ural Mountain region of Central Russia. Distribution to more than 385,000 people will last four months.

ADRA Germany is seeking financial aid to provide food to the European parts of the for-

mer Soviet Union as well.

In Liberia, ADRA has begun an emergency education program for the refugee children in the Cote d'Ivoire (Ivory Coast). Approximately 15,000 primary school children will benefit from the project.
