The lives of married men may be insured for the benefit of their wives and children, so that upon the decease of the insured, the wife living, if not then his children will receive the amount payable by the policy, free and clear of any claim by the creditors of the deceased.

For the greater security of parties insuring with this company, the Trustees have provided an indemnity fund, the amount of \$250,000 to meet losses that may accrue upon policies issued by the company which is to remain until a capital exceeding one thousand shall have been realized from the receipt of premiums when it will be no longer necessary, and may be withdrawn.
