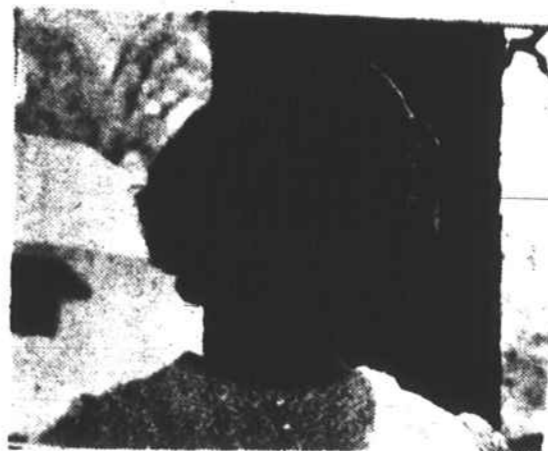
Choir Presents Musical

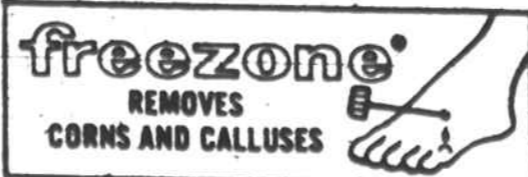
