Verse 7&8 - Jesus told Nicodemus he shouldn't be surprised about what He was saying. You can't see the wind or tell where it's coming from or where it went. So it is with the spirit of God. Everyone born of the spirit is led by the spirit, they can't see it or tell it's here before it gets to them, yet it guides and direct's their life, because they are of a new birth and a new person.
