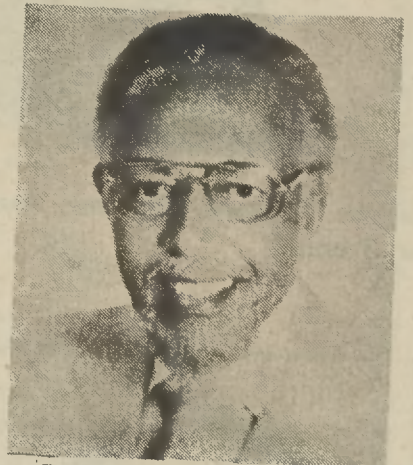
Workshop at St. Stephens

### WORDS OF LIFE

#### Biblical Inspiration For The Week

"The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want."

Psalm 23:1

**I—We Need A Guide.** A shepherd is a guide. Unless we have a worthy guide, we become — in a sense — like the self-losing sheep. A sheep who is lost (that is, becomes a "loser") doesn't consciously get off the track. Such a one simply nibbles away at the grass without keeping an eye on the shepherd; and then eventually discovers that he (or she) has nibbled himself away from his guide. That's the way we all get lost, by either straying from or not having a guide.

**II—We Need To Learn From Others.** One of the greatest faults or temptations of youth is the impetuous and impossible assumption that "we can do everything on our own."

Those who are wisest are those who learn every hour of every day, from reflection on the experiences of others.

The Scriptures tell us that a Good Shepherd leads his (or her) sheep, that he (or she) goes before them. The Good

Shepherd doesn't follow because the Good Shepherd has been over the path before and knows where the journey should end.

**III—The Good Shepherd Cares.** All of us need someone to care for us. There are no self-made men or women? Can you imagine anyone who has been self-conceived, self-born, self-fed and self-nurtured?

Such a person would be a hermaphrodite, a queer creature posing as a human being, indeed!

When we are in the care of a good family, a good husband or wife, and — better still — of God's family, the Church, we want for nothing. This is Creation's plan for our provision, for the fulfillment of all our needs, forever.

God's family is the Church. For each of us the Church is our Father's house, and so our home. Come home!
