HITTORYMAKING BLACK HAPPENINGS:

BALTIMORE, MARY-LAND-Congressman Parren Mitchell, newly elected chairman of the Congressional Black Caucus had scarcely announced that the Black Caucus had received Carter assurances of black "appointments to the Cabinet" when the hope of appointments became the occasion of monumental "disappointment." Left out on a shaky limb were black Mayors Kenneth Gibson of Newark and Coleman

Young of Detroit who had defended the new president's integrity as the cabinet selection process unfolded.

CHICAGO, ILLINOIS—
Chicago's black Alderman
Wilson Frost claimed the
