Did you ever see a fisherman seemingly casting to the other side of the lake? Well those long casts were a great waste of time and effort. The longer the cast, the less water one is able to cover. Short casts to the shoreline means more area covered and also a minimum of line stretch; a handicap when setting the hook. When a catch is made make note of the cover and structure and water conditions, depths and etc. Fish similar areas and most likely your entire catch for that particular day will be taken under the same conditions.

To establish patterns we try several lures in various covers and structures. When a lure pays off we continue the use of that lure under the conditions that proved productive. In most cases the pattern will produce fish the remainder of that day. Tomorrow the pattern can be drastically changed. Setting patterns for any fresh water fish can be developed providing we use a sure fire element; concentration.

around. My favorite colors are black and purple. Plastic worms can net some fine catches; real big ones. If you have never hung into a big bass, early spring is the best time to go after one. I am not partial to bass fishing, but big bass present a great challenge. I just love to fish. Bream on a flyrod or crappie on a cane pole is a fishing delight. On a cane pole, a big catfish can be mighty stubborn lying on the bottom.

I have never developed the skill for hanging carp. I learned that one must wait on the carp to take the bait and run, to me this seems like forever. The moment my line moves I can not hold still, I must set my hook. This has proven to be my undoing, I

have never caught carp. It's all fishing so pick your specie or just fish for fish. The idea is to catch something to make the trip interesting, but if you fail to make a catch, all has not been in vain. Just think of the pleasure you had trying.
