With Holtz, who has been called a racist, out of the way and Walt Michaels at the controls the team has hired its first black assistant. Michaels, the man who should have gotten the head coaching job last season when "Lucky Lou" was lured off the N.C. State campus in Raleigh, hopefully has a more professional attitude than his predesessor.

203 Ecoconer 12, an assistant at oramoling State University (where else?) last season, will work with the running backs and assist on special teams according to the announcement made by the Jets.

One person who may be more happy than others to see Ledbetter in that position could be Fayetteville State's James Godwin. The former CIAA star was drafted by the Jets last season, but was cut before the season started.

After being cut by Holtz, Godwin said he felt he wasn't given a fair chance, because he came from a small black school. "He was not being completely honest in his appraisal of my abilities because I came from a small black school."

If Godwin should decide to try out for the team again this summer he shouldn't have that problem to worry about. Ledbetter is a former head coach at Norfolk State College of the CIAA.

Ledbetter, a native of Tuepelo, Miss and a graduate of Mississippi Industrial College has pro experience working as an aide with the New Orleans Saints in 1974-75.

He becomes the Jets first full time black assistant coach in their 18-year history. The Jets have had black scouts who did some coaching in training camp in the past, but none coached during the season.

Back at North Carolina State Holtz successor Bo Rein has also hired a black coach. Bishop Harris 35, has been chosen offensive line coach. Harris, a 1963 North Carolina Central graduate served as a scout, recruiter and defensive end coach at Duke from 1972 through 75. He was head coach at Raleigh's Broughton High School last year.

Still there are no black head football coaches on the major college level or in the pro ranks.
