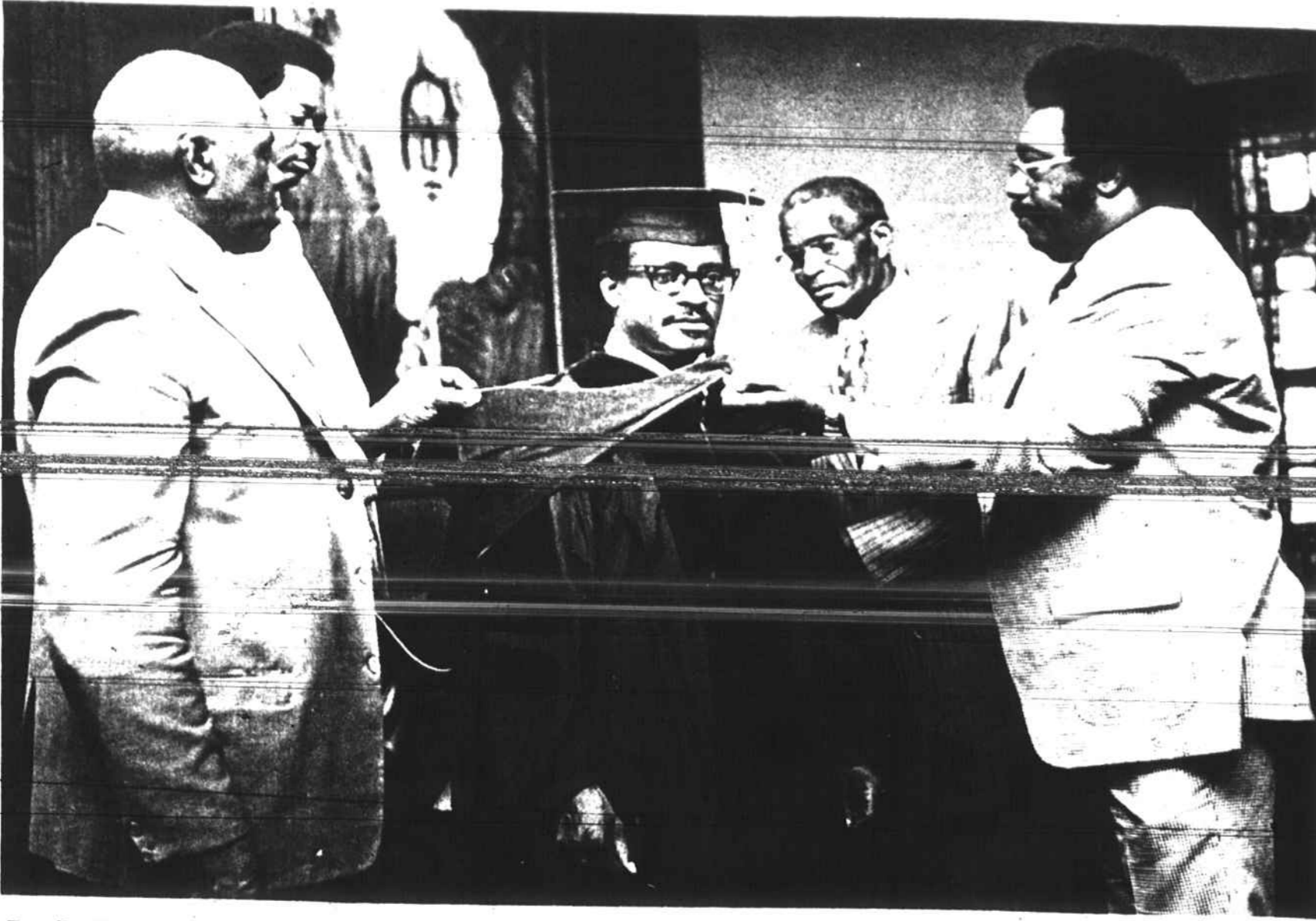

This has been true with Dr. J. Ray Butler, the eminent Pastor of the Shiloh Baptist Church of Winston-Salem, N.C., when he became recommended as a worthy and acceptable personality to be honored by the McKinley Theological Seminary of Jackson, Mississippi where Dr. N.K. Nelson is president. The Doctor of Laws Degree (LL.D.) was conferred upon Pastor Butler at Shiloh Baptist Church on Sunday, July 24th at 5:00 P.M. This honor was to be conferred upon him at the Annual service of recognition of the Midwestern Baptist Church during the month of May, where Dr. Albert Williams, Managing Editor of the National Baptist Voice, is president. The Service in Chicago was a conflict of the National Award as with Dr. Butler because of the week of Revival Services in Pittsburgh, Pa. beginning on the same Sunday that the special recognition service was held.

Butler is the recipient of earned degrees from Shaw University and Divinity School with the A.B. and B.D. Degrees. The M.Div. Degree received, 1972; The Doctor of Divinity Degree from Friendship College, 1964; and Shaw Divinity School of Shaw University, 1973. He has done post graduate work toward the D.Th. Degree at the Southeastern Seminary, Wake Forest University, 1967-68.

Dr. Butler is well travelled, touring the Middle East, 1972; the Holy Land and Athens Greece; Seven European Countries in 1975 and parts of West Africa touring countries of Nigeria and Liberia, November 1976. Dr. Butler, a recipient of the National Award as Pastor of the Year (1975) awarded by the Midwestern Baptist Laymen's Fellowship also received permanent possession of trophy in 1976 for outstanding leadership elected contributing writer for the National Baptist Sunday School Publishing Board. He is Chairman of the General Board of the General Baptist State Convention and occupies chief positions with the National Baptist Organizations. Locally, he is the president of the Forsyth Clergy Association of Winston-Salem and Vicinity and Vice president of the Baptist Ministers Conference and Associates and several other organizations.

He is married to the former Marion Lucas of Durham, North Carolina and they have four sons.
