Sealed Bids will be received by the Purchasing Department of the City of Winston-Salem, Council Chamber of City Hall, Winston-Salem, North Carolina until 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, Oct. 12, 1977; at which time the Bids will be opened and read publicly for the construction of the following:

The project consists of construction of a one story clubhouse with a full basement for cart storage. There is approximately 4,300 square feet per level. The basement walls are reinforced concrete masonry with face brick at exposed locations. There will be a 5" concrete basement slab on grade. The main floor will be a 3" to 5" concrete slab on metal decking on metal bar joists. The exterior walls will be a 10" cavity wall of 4" face brick and 4" CMU. Wood frame, double glazed combination window units with screens at the awning section are used as shown on the drawings. The roof structure will be a combination of wood gang nail trusses with plywood sheathing and exposed bolted wood trusses and wood deck. The entire roof area will be covered with cedar shakes. Interior partitions will be wood frame with gypsum wall board covering. Carpet and hard tile will be applied to the concrete deck. There will be acoustical tile ceiling with

fluorescent and incandescent lighting. An electric heat pump will provide heating and cooling. A snack bar will be included consisting of food service equipment. Paved driveways and limited parking areas along with curbs and gutter shall be included. There will be demolition of existing structures after completion of the new building all as indicated on the drawings.

Bids must be on the standard form provided by the Owner and must be marked to identify the type of prime contract noted herein before. A complete set of documents may be obtained, by those qualified and who will make a bid, upon placing a deposit of \$Ten & No/100 Dollars (\$10.00). The full deposit will be returned to those submitting bona fide proposals, provided the plans and specifications are returned to the proper authority in good condition and within five days after the date set for receiving bids. (Sub-contractors who desire sets of plans for their own use will be charged cost of reproduction and handling.)

All contractors are hereby notified that they must have proper license under the state laws governing their respective trades at time of submitting the bid. Consideration will be given only to bids of contractors who submit evidence showing that they are properly licensed to bid and perform the work described herein under an "Act to Regulate the Practice of General Contracting" ratified by the General Assembly of North Carolina on March 10, 1925, and subsequently amended.
Wage rates paid for labor must not be less than the prevailing area wages as determined by the Secretary of Labor, pursuant to the provisions of the Davis-Bacon Act wage decision applicable for the project location.
All contractors are hereby notified that they
