## Dedication Service To Be Held For Mt. Pleasant

The members of Mt. Pleasant Baptist Church will have the dedication of their new church, also celebrate the 86th anniversary of the church, Sunday, March 12, 1978 at 4:00 o'clock p.m.

The Rev. Henry S. Lewis, Jr., the former pastor of the church, will preach.

The new church has a seating capacity of 250 in the sanctuary and 40 in the choir loft. For historical reason, the church has retained some of the pews which are handmade, from its first church. They are placed in the Fellowship Hall downstairs. Also downstairs, is the office, pastor's study, choir room, storage room, kitchen, conference room, nursery, and ladies and men's rooms. The new church is located on Glenn Avenue just behind the old church which is being demolished. The land on which the old church stood will become a parking lot for the present church.

In the year 1892, a community Sunday School was organized and held its meetings in a building called Chess Ingram Hall. This was located on Oldtown Road (now North Cherry Street). It was there that Mt. Pleasant Baptist Church was organized. The first building was erected in 1893 a few feet from this old hall. In 1919, the church purchased property on Kimberly Road and started making plans for a new

church building. It was completed in 1925.

For fifty-two years (1925-1977) the Mt. Pleasant Baptist Church membership worshipped at 1731 Kimberly Road. During these years, the following ministers served as pastor: Rev. G.C. Crawford (first administration), Rev. R.M. Pitts, Rev. W.F. Carlson, Rev. G.C. Crawford (Second Administration) & Rev. Charles Greene.

In October, 1966, Rev. Henry S. Lewis was called to be pastor. Under Rev. Lewis's guidance and lead-

ership, a building fund program and plans for a new church were started. The ground breaking was held August 8, 1976 and construction began Sept. 1976. The work was completed December, 1977. The first service in the new church was Dec. 11, 1977.

Rev. Lewis served Mt. Pleasant 11 years. He submitted his resignation September, 1977 and it was effective December, 1977. He has accepted a position as Assistant Pastoral Counselor with R.J. Reynolds Industries.
