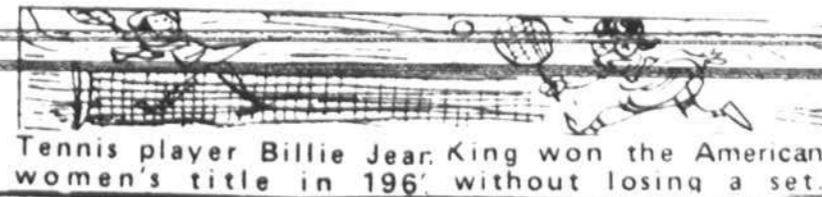


Spillman Presents Recital At Shiloh

Organist Herndon Spillman will present a recital at Shiloh Baptist Church at 1210 S. Eugene St. in Greensboro on Sunday, April 9 at 7 p.m., in the church sanctuary. The public is invited to attend the recital which will mark the beginning of a three-week celebration of Shiloh's 86th anniversary. Spillman, assistant professor of music and chairman of the Organ Department at Louisiana State University in Baton Rouge, will give his recital on a 40-voice pipe organ that is augmented with electronics, the first such organ to be installed in the state.

Spillman's program will include works by Olivier Messiaen, Cesar Franck, Johann S. Bach and Thomas Kerr, a black composer. Spillman has studied at Dillard and Indiana universities and holds a degree as doctor of music in organ performance from Indiana University School of Music. At Indiana University, he served as assistant to the director and research associate at the School of Music's Black Music Center, and there

Spillman has also studied in Paris, France, under direction of Marie-Claire Alaine, Maurice Durufle and Andrea Marchal. In Paris, he concentrated on 17th and 18th century music. In 1975, the French Academy of Records awarded him the Grand Prix du Disque for the first complete works of Maurice Durufle.

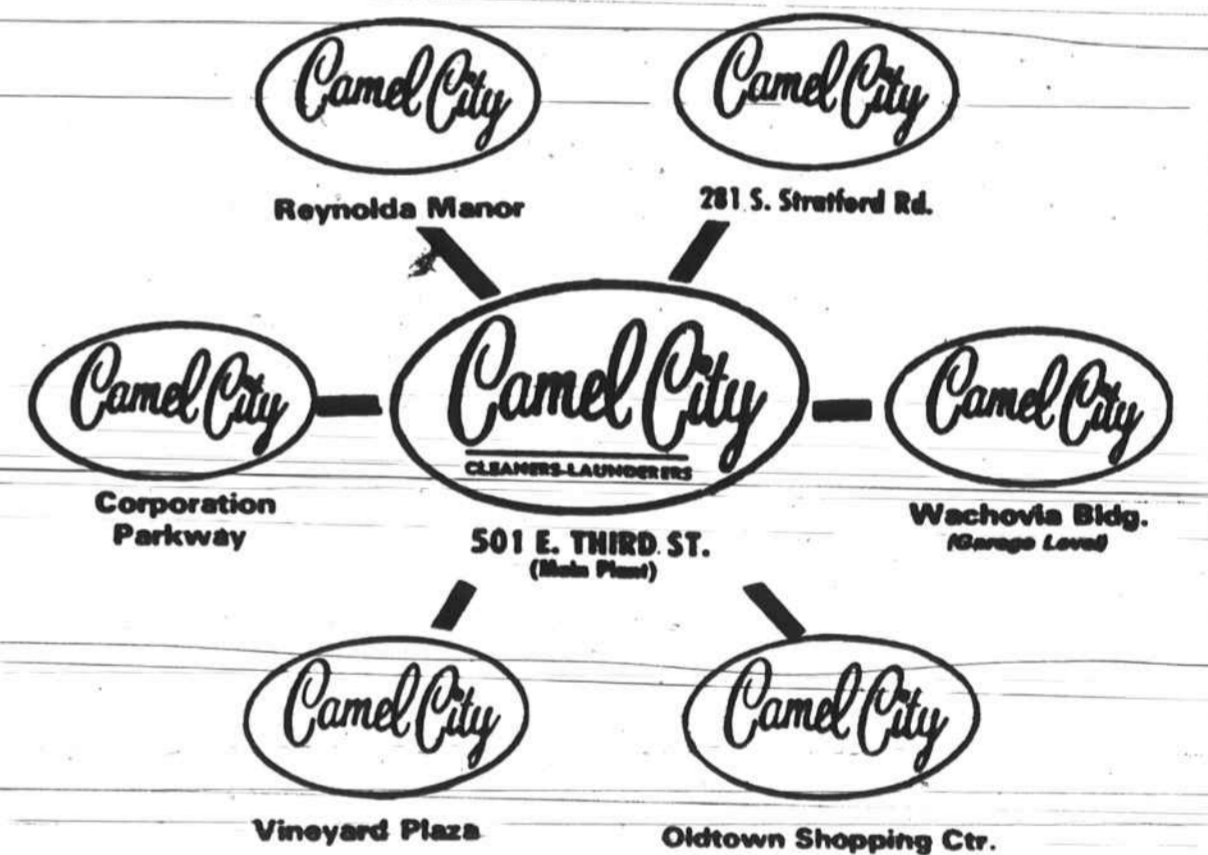
