

In CIAA Tourney

Ramettes Win 3rd Place

The WSSU womens' basketball team rebounded from an icy cold shooting night on Friday to drub St. Augustine's 87-57 in the consolation of the CIAA womens' basketball tourney this past weekend in Elizabeth City.

Freshman Linda Lee scored 23 points and grabbed 18 rebounds and Lauriece Jenkins netted 21 points and 6 assists for the victors who jumped to a 44-27 halftime lead. The Ramettes, who also got 13 points and 14 rebounds from substitute Lora Smith shot 52 percent from the floor while their defense limited the Lady Falcons to 23 baskets on 99 shots from

the field. The Ramettes, top seeded in the events, had not shot well in Thursday night's win over St. Paul's, making only 34 of 86 shots for 39.5 percent. In a game that was not as close as the score indicated the Ramettes pulled away to a 15-4 lead and ran the margin to 61-40 midway of the final 20 minutes. They led 41-28 at the half. Lee and Jenkins again were the big guns for the winners with 21 and 20 points respectively. Lee also led all rebounders with 17.

They failed to regain their shooting touch in Fri-

day night's semifinals, losing to eventual champion Fayetteville State 88-84 in double overtime.

WSSU went up 37-34 at the half and built a 12 point lead early in the final period before foul trouble and cold shooting allowed the Bronco women to charge back. Wanda Robertson fouled out with 7 minutes remaining after hitting 8 of 12 field goals. The Lady Broncos knotted the score at 71 all at the end of regulation and sent the same into overtime. The first overtime period ended with the two teams still tied at 78. But the Fayetteville women outscored the Ramettes 10-6 in the last five

minute period to record the win. Five Ramettes scored in double figures led by Brenda Winfield with 18.

Lauriece Jenkins and Brenda Winfield were named to the All-Tournament team while Jenkins and freshman Linda Lee were named All-conference.

Lee was left off the All-tourney team despite scoring 61 points and getting 46 rebounds in the three games.

The Ramettes began AIAW division 11 tournament play in impressive fashion Tuesday night routing UNC-Asheville 88-49 as Jenkins scored 23 points and Lee 16. Wanda Robertson and Lora Smith added 12 each for the winners who advanced to semifinal action while improving their record to 19-8.

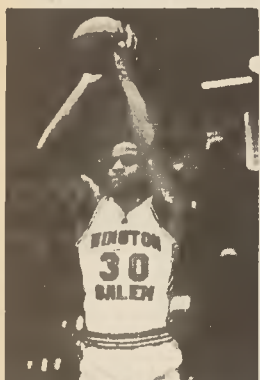


Your outboard motor, whether you use it for fishing or boating pleasures, should have been winterized. If it wasn't you may be in for some unexpected troubled hours while you are on the lakes. Here's hoping the foot did not accumulate too much water during your last season of operation, if it did you may end up with a cracked housing near the propeller. If the pistons are frozen, seem to be stuck that is, it may be safer to let an outboard motor mechanic take it from there. He will have the right lubricants to do the job of freeing the

pistons.

The inclement weather will not retard the entry of Spring. When it does come around Ol' Mother Nature will do the rest and you can depend upon the fish to do their part. They are sure to be on the move, and for you to get your share of some good fishing you had better be there. By starting early, right after the thaw, you will, no doubt, be on hand to get some big bass. I have learned that the biggest bass are caught between the last of February and latter part of April. After that it is a hit and miss proposition.

To prove my point; my record of big bass caught during the stated period was an 8 pounder on March 17, a 9-9 pounder on April 17, and an 11 pounder on April 20. On those chilly mornings I suffered with cold fingers but, the pleasure was well worth the discomforts. If you are a regular bass fisherman you are aware of these experiences. If you have never fished during the early season, try it, you are missing some good fishing if you don't. Make a promise to get in more fishing this coming season, you will be doing yourself a favor.
