Children Attracted To Poison

More than 90 percent of the cases of accidental swallowing of poisons involve children age 5 or under.

According to specialists with the North Carolina Agricultural Extension Service, the majority of incidents occur inside the home; mainly in the bathroom and kitchen and nearly half the time when the product is in use.

During National Poison Week, March 18-24, they remind parents that containers of household cleaners, improperly stored or carelessly placed while being used, can tempt the inquisitiveness of a child and tempt him or her to taste the contents.

It's not always feasible to lock up all household cleaners and medicines, but it is possible to reorganize the space you have and set up child-proof areas in the home, they say.

By adhering to the following safety measures in handling and storing potentially harmful substances, incidents of poisoning can be reduced:

Carefully read directions, special instructions and warnings on packages and containers of household cleaning products. Federal law requires that product labels list all hazardous substances. The label also gives first aid information.

Keep household cleaning products in original containers. Don't put them in cups, bowls or soda bottles.

According to the National Clearinghouse for Poison Control Centers, a high portion of accidental ingestion of household chemicals occurs when a user transfers the product into a cup or glass. The child may assume it is something to eat or drink.

In addition, the original container carries a label, identifying the product and its manufacturer - essential information in the event of poisoning.

Keep the product in view while in use. A pause to answer a phone or the door bell is all it takes for a toddler to reach an unguarded container. If you own an automatic dishwasher, be sure not to leave the door lid open after placing dishwasher detergent in the dispenser.

Arrange drawers and cabinets for safe storage. Cleaning supplies stored under the kitchen or bathroom sink, in accessible drawers, behind easy-to-open, unlocked cabinet doors are a Pandora's box for the curious child, say the specialists.

All household cleaning agents should be kept in upper cabinets in the kitchen or bath, or on high shelves in linen closets and laundry rooms. These include bleach, washing soda, detergents, fabric softeners and other laundry aids; ammonia, drain, toilet bowl and oven cleaners, all-purpose cleaners, insecticides, mothballs, polishes and some cosmetics.

Paint thinners, paint, lighter fuel, other petroleum solvents, fertilizers, plant sprays and similar materials are best kept in metal closets withlocks, preferably outside the home.

Store prescription drugs and other medications, including aspirin and vitamins well out of reach. Be sure containers have safety tops when possible. Never call medicines or vitamins "candy", say the specialists.
