"My waterbill went up from washing my car so much," said Boyd.
 "It was terrible," said Mrs. Lee Faye Mack, president of the group. "My car always stayed out of line."
 The groups has petitioned and appeared before the Board of Aldermen for over three years in support of the street paving. Finally, it was included in this year's budget.
 That battle won, the group has other concerns such as gutters on their homes, and recreation for their children. "This is the only Turnkey project in the city without a recreational area," said Mrs. Mack, community worker with the Winston-Salem Urban League. "We got to do something to get these kids involved in."


