passers-by. "Many days I've looked out and you'd be surprised at the people cheering him on."

Thompson calls the title for the car his "smoking pistol." Just after the car was reported missing, the title was returned by the Division of Motor Vehicles because the original owner who transferred title to the dealership had not signed in the designated space.

However, the reassignment of title was notarized by Betty B. Beeson, at the time a title clerk for West. Jim Jones of the local Register of Deeds office said the title should not have been notarized in the absence of the signature.

Asked about the title, We st said that the original owner assigned a document granting the power of attorney to the dealership for the title. "Raleigh says it was unattached when it got to them. All we would have to do is to attach another, but he won't attach another to it."
