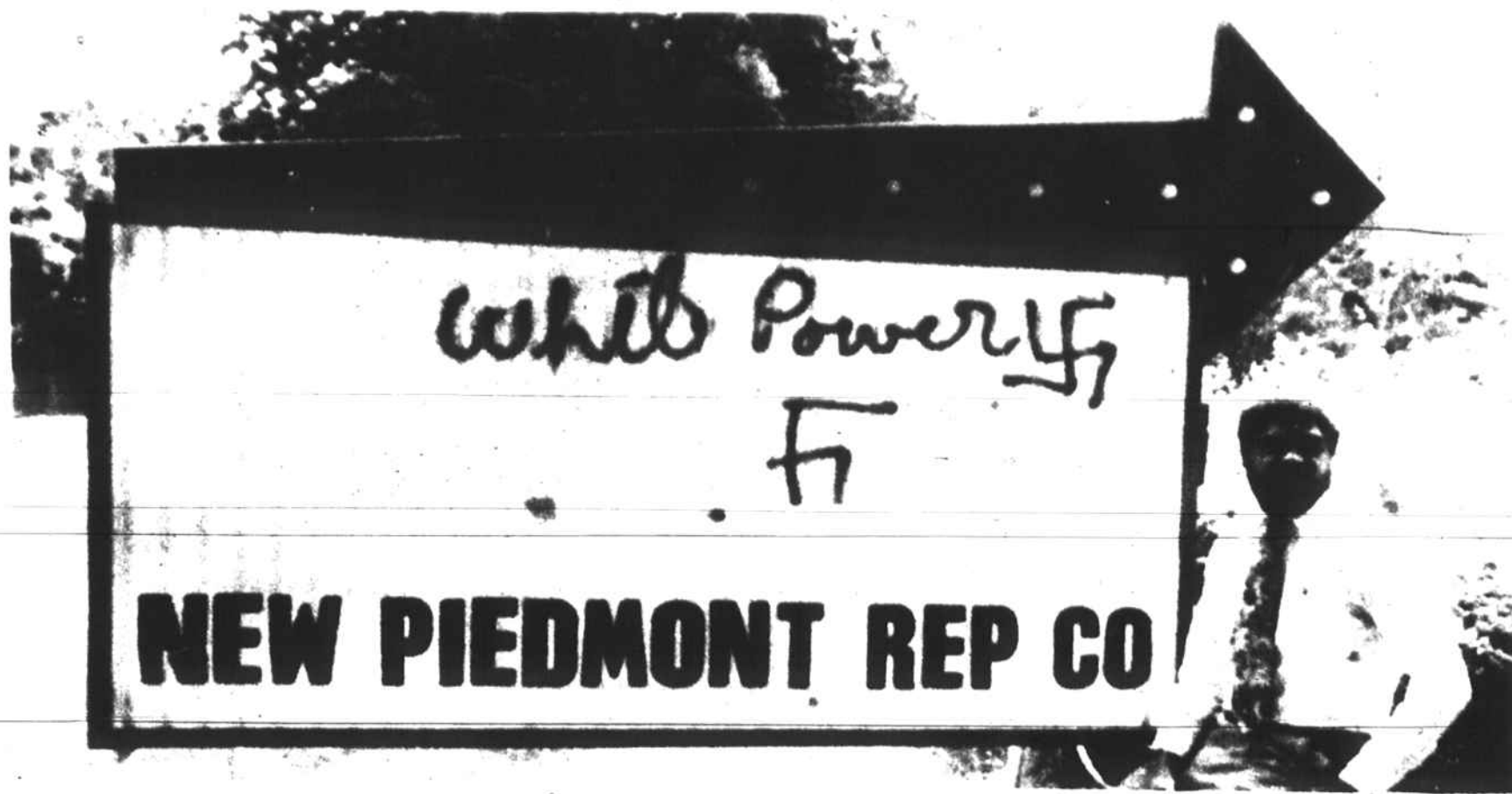

Friday night pranksters knocked a hole in a street sign pointing to the New Piedmont Repertory Company's production of "To Be Young, Gifted and Black" and spray-painted "white power" and the Nazi swastika on both sides of the sign.

"Here we are doing a play talking about a better world for all of us, and this happened," said an angry director Coleman S. Freeman.

The sign was located on Reynolda Road, just across from the Reynolda House entrance and in front of the Summit School, which allows the company use of its theatre for its season of plays.

Freeman said the incident apparently happened last Friday night. "When I came in for the Saturday performance, the actors and actresses were nervous," said Freeman. "They insisted on having someone watch the audience for any trouble."

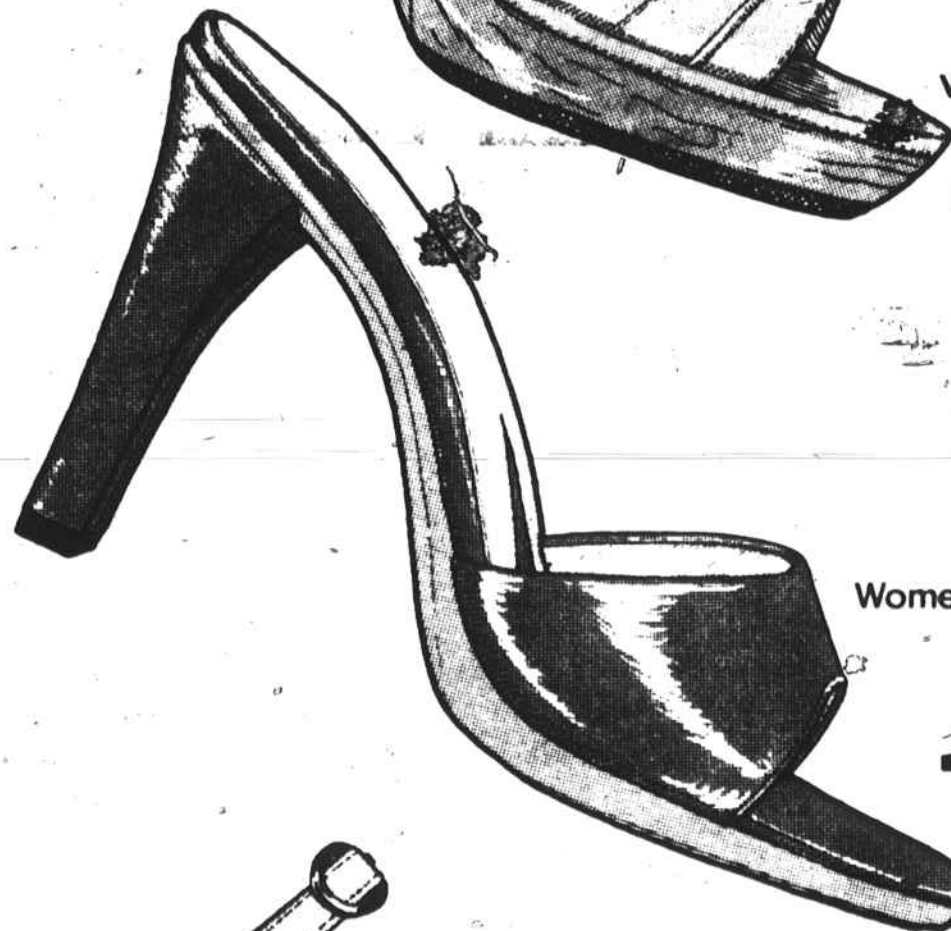

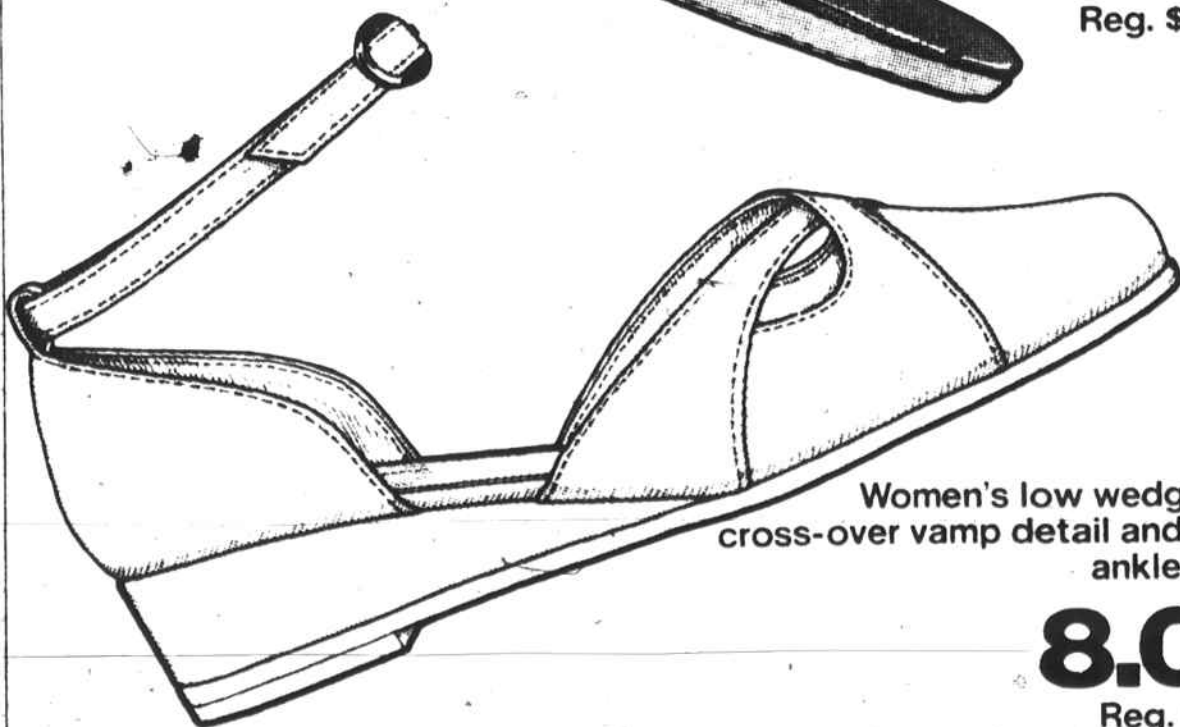

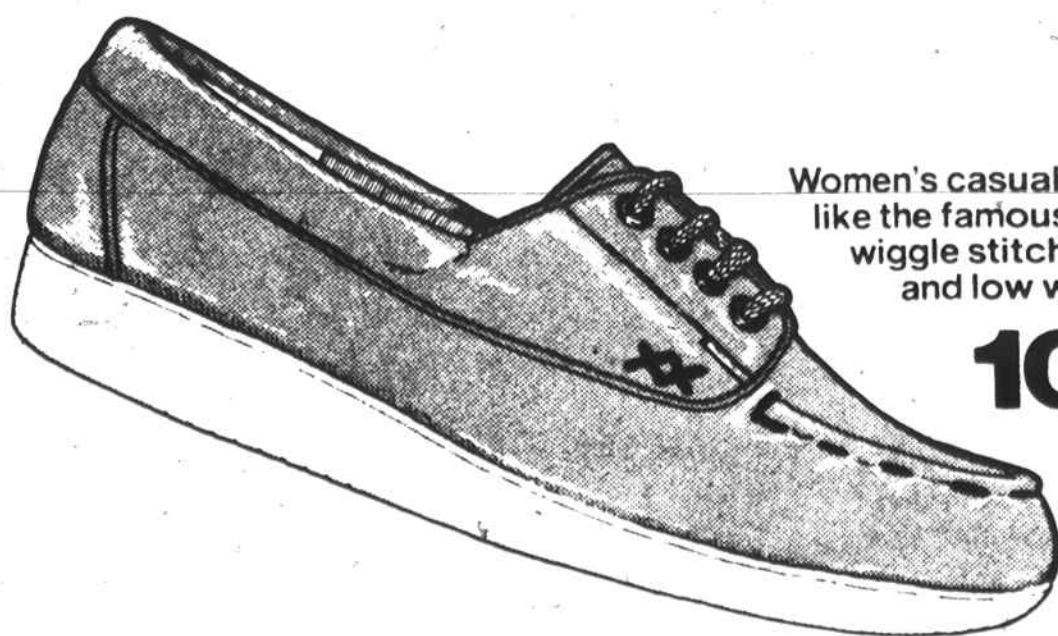
